## Two-Bin System Will Reduce Contamination



### Changes Beginning November 2017

The City is implementing a two-bin recycling system for residential customers in the City limits. We will begin home delivery of your additional bin on November 1st. It may take a couple of weeks to complete the delivery process.

This serves two purposes:

- Reduces contamination of recycled material
- Simplifies our separation of recycled material

Place recycling bins at the curbside by 7 a.m. on your collection day.



## Green Bin

### Paper & Cardboard

- Mail, office and school papers
- Newspapers
- Magazines & catalogs
- Paperback books and telephone directories
- Shredded paper – **must** be placed in 13 gallon or smaller plastic trash bags
- **Fiberboard boxes** – cereal, cracker & storage boxes. Must be **Broken down**.
- **Corrugated cardboard boxes** **Broken down**, flattened & cut into pieces 2 feet x 3 feet or smaller.

## Blue Bin

### Plastic (Labeled #1 - #7)

- CD's & CD cases
- Detergent bottles
- Cleaning containers
- Plastic beverage & food containers

### Glass

- Glass bottles & jars. Place tops/lids in your garbage.
- Labels do not need to be removed.

### Food & Beverage Cartons, including:

- Milk/creamer cartons
- Juice boxes
- Soup & broth cartons

### Metal

- Steel & aluminum cans & food containers
- Baking tins



## Household Hazardous Waste

- Pesticides
- Paint
- Solvents
- Fuels
- Fertilizers
- Pool cleaner
- Auto cleaner
- Used oil

Monday-Saturday**

## Items NOT Included in Recycling Program

- Plastic toys, plastic grocery bags, clothes hangers
- Pizza boxes
- Motor oil containers
- Pool & other chemical containers
- Mirrors, window glass & broken glass
- Aerosol cans, electronics & pesticide containers
- Styrofoam (ie: egg cartons and trays)

## Solid Waste Department's Other Services

### Garbage

- Garbage must be bagged, tied & placed in the container provided by the City. **Do not place loose garbage in the container.**
- Place by the curbside no later than 7 a.m. on your collection day.

### Yard Waste

- Place grass, leaves & other loose items in plastic bags for pickup.
- You may place tree limbs up to 4 inches in diameter and 4 feet long at the curbside.
- Limit your yard trash to a maximum of 20 bags and one parallel stack, **no** more than 3 feet x 3 feet x 6 feet.

### Bulky Items (By appointment only)

- Call (904) 297-7060.
- Appliances and furniture may be picked up once a month by **appointment only** in the following quantities:
  - Furniture – Two pieces
  - Appliances – One item. **NOTE: that Federal Law requires that all refrigerators & freezers shall have ALL doors removed prior to being placed outside.**
